While traveling to Tuzla, they stopped in Belgrade, where Matej got the opportunity to meet the director of the local chapter of the Konrad Adenaur Stiftung, Jakov Devčić who was very positive about the program and offered his support for a future developments of the program in the region.

On the way to Zagreb, Tim and Matej, stopped on the farm Ramarin, where they met with Marin Samardžić who is managing the farm with a lot of emphasis on the values and sustainable development.
