On **Saturday, 28th of May** together with our partners from **Late Night Diplomacy** and **Lastavica**, we have organized the **first edition of a charity event** with the aim to raise funds for the organization of the summer camp for almost 100 youngsters from homes for children without parental care from different countries in the region of Western Balkans. Apart from our main intention to raise funds, we also wanted people to come **to celebrate our first year of the Speechless Reconciliation** together with other supporters.

As a part of the program for our attendees, we have prepared a surprise for our guests. **The surprise of the evening was the announcement of our partners from the Late Night Diplomacy, who announced the grant of 10 full scholarships for 10 youngsters** from homes for children without proper parental care as part of their new program that will be taking place **in 5 different countries of Europe**. We believe that this is one of the opportunities that will open many doors for them.



The event was a **huge success** and we hope to see as many of the attendees as possible also next year!
